Why Bother Building a Field?


Benefits of a strong "field"

- Reduced societal burdens and maximized opportunities






What Do We Mean by The 4 Ps?



- Purpose common problem understanding, unifying vision of a better future; shared values; agreed-upon priorities; shared sense of urgency
- People adequate (growth in) numbers; requisite diversity of expertise; good networking; inclusivity; sectors, regions represented; recognizable leadership
- Practices evidence-based "best practices"; prevailing focus of activity; progress matching scope of challenge; adequate communication; skill level among practitioners
- Pillars of support diversity and adequacy of funding/ finance; continuity, coordination of funding streams; policy support at all levels; signals from highly visible leaders to take issue seriously; field-building support






